Community Care Behavioral Health is a psychiatric partial care day program licensed by the Division of Mental Health Services, led by a management team with over 30 years of professional experience working with consumers with severe and acute mental illness. The program provides a comprehensive array of psychiatric rehabilitation treatment and services that include case management, counseling, group therapy, skills building groups, co-occurring disorders groups, psychoeducation, psychiatric evaluations and medication monitoring, pre-vocational and work skills groups, therapeutic recreational and social activities. CCBH provides specialized tracks for individuals, who in addition to having a mental illness also have substance abuse issues or developmental disabilities.

Consumers are encouraged to believe that change is possible, that they can learn or acquire skills necessary to reach their goals and to actively participate in their recovery through participation in a variety of groups and activities.

Admission Criteria

- NJ Resident, 18 years or older
- Medicaid Recipient or Eligibility for Specialized Medical Benefits
- History of Psychiatric Illness/ History of Psychiatric Hospitalization or at risk of Psychiatric Hospitalization
- Reasonable expectation of benefiting from this level of partial care treatment

Transportation

Is provided by CCBH vans or by Board of Social Services contracted Medicaid taxi companies. Piscataway program (Middlesex, Union and Somerset Counties). Freehold program (Monmouth and Ocean Counties).
